Unequal Impacts of Climate Extremes among Coastal Communities in the Philippines

This talk explores how the Sama Badjao, sea-oriented Indigenous community in the Philippines, experiences and responds to climate extreme weather, and structural marginalization. Drawing post-disaster fieldwork after on Super Typhoon Rai in 2021-2022, it highlights how their recovery process and adaptive practices reveal deeper questions of justice and resilience amid intensifying climate crises.
